LOBBY

BUILDING 1

Table with 4 columns: Booth ID, Dimensions, Price, and Notes. Includes rows 108, 118, 119, 136, 200, and 713-707.

BUILDING 2

Table with 4 columns: Booth ID, Dimensions, Price, and Notes. Includes rows 1212, 1912, 2031, 2034, and 2042.

NOTES:

- 1. 02 - Door in rear of booth must have clearance to swing open
2. 05, 108, 1212, 1912 - Firehouse cabinet must remain visible and door must be able to swing open
3. 119, 2031- No curtain in front of vents; 12-18" clearance required in front of vent
4. 2042 - No curtain in front of vents; 12-18" clearance required in front of vent; firehouse cabinet to be visible

LAST TO MOVE IN / FIRST TO MOVE OUT:

Trucks and forklifts off loading materials use this space. These booths will not be assembled by show services until 1:00 on Thursday. Any items moved in before this time runs the risk of being damaged and LHBA cannot be held responsible.

SHOW DETAILS

MOVE IN: Wed. Jan 28 8am - 8pm,
Thurs Jan 29 8am - 8pm - Vehicles inside until noon only: aisles cleared by 3pm
Fri Jan 30 8am - 11:30 am - Carry in only

MOVE OUT: Sunday Feb 2nd 5pm - 8pm - Carts and vehicles only after aisle carpet removed
Monday Feb 3rd 8am - 4pm - All material must be out by 4pm

DRAPE/PIPE DIMENSIONS:

Curtaining is provided. Standard layout - rear 8' high across full width of booth. Side 8' high for 4' from the rear, 3' high for 6' to the front edge of the booth. Any exhibitor wanting a different curtain layout or wanting to provide his or her own walls that do not fit these dimension, must request written permission from the LHBA before December 1st, 2019. LHBA reserves the right to grant permission to change these dimensions on a case-by-case basis.

ELECTRICAL:

- Not included in booth rental; arrangements to be made through Stronco Show Services as the show supplier; see order form www.lifestylehomeshow.ca; discount offer prior to deadline date
- Heavy Hydro - not available in Building 1, limited in Building 2; please check availability with your sales representative
- No additional overhead lighting available
- No extension cord or power bars available on site; if exhibitors bring their own, minimum 25'
- ESA inspections are conducted before show opening to identify any electrical hazards that may be present as a result of unsafe practices when the vendors have completed their temporary electrical hook-ups. This may consist of damaged equipment, grounding issues, unapproved equipment for sale or in use, misuse of extension cords/power bars, etc. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring their booths are properly wired in keeping with ESA requirements, the exhibitor is responsible for any extra charges levied against the Lifestyle Home Show/London Home Builders' Association for contraventions within their display.

FLOOR COVERING: All floor space must have a suitable floor covering; not included in booth rental; may be ordered through Stronco or provided by exhibitor.

FORK LIFT: Contact loading supervisor on Loading Dock along west side of building 2.

NATURAL GAS: Not available in Lobby or Building 1; specific locations only in Building 2; to confirm availability, check with your sales representative. To order, contact Stronco.

INSURANCE: Exhibitor to obtain at its own expense during the period commencing on the first move-in date and terminating on the last move-out date a policy of \$2 million liability insurance acceptable to your sales representative.

INTERNET: The Lifestyle Home Show provides free wireless internet where applicable, but does not guarantee this to be secure and does not encourage sensitive transactions; dedicated internet lines may be arranged through Stronco.

LOADING DOCK: 3 loading docks located on the east side of Building 2.

HELIUM TANKS AND BALLOONS: Helium tanks are not permitted on site. Balloons can only be used to decorate a booth or room. No balloons of any type are allowed to be distributed at this event without prior approval of your sales representative.

VEHICLES IN THE SHOW: Any vehicle left on site must have the battery disconnected and have a low fuel level. Keys are to be left in the show office in case of emergency after hours.

SELLING: Is permitted at the Lifestyle Home Show but all products to be sold must be clearly specified on the contract before booth space will be confirmed; sales of unauthorized products at the show will be stopped.

SHIPPING ADDRESS: Western Fair District, 845 Florence Street, London, ON M5W 6G6

SIGN HANGING: All signage must not overhang or encroach upon adjacent exhibits or be visible above the booth behind your space. Two sided signs must be covered on the back. NO EXCEPTIONS. Signs to be hung by Western Fair District will be at a charge based on the size and number of signs and level of difficulty and can be ordered through Stronco. NOTE - No signs can be hung in Building 1.

WATER ACCESS: Building 1- NONE, Building 2- along the perimeter.
